Fundación Huellas Verdes offers enterprises and institutions a means to offset their carbon emissions by planting vetiver, a grass storing carbon in its roots. When introduced to areas with slopes at risk of landslides, vetiver protects neighbouring communities by preventing erosion.

#### **BUSINESS MODEL**

Fundación Huellas Verdes works together with its clients to determine their needs for carbon offsets. Areas with a high risk of landslides are then identified and planted with vetiver, locally known as Tiva, in cooperation with municipalities, government agencies, and local communities, thereby preventing erosion and offsetting carbon emissions.

The clients of Fundación Huellas Verdes receive a certificate for their annual carbon emission offsets over the next 50 years, as well as a "carbon neutral" stamp.

#### Social impacts:

- Reducing the risk of landslides that impact infrastructure, homes, and can lead to loss of life.
- Strengthening the capacity of local civil society organisations and government institutions to adapt to climate change.

## **Environmental impacts:**

- Absorbing carbon emissions through planting vetiver grass on degraded slopes.
- Using organic fertiliser for the vetiver plantations to prevent negative environmental impacts.
- Stabilising at-risk slopes, thus preventing soil erosion, landslides, and contamination of water sources, as well as contributing to drought management.

### **Economic impacts:**

- Contracting labour from the affected community, thereby generating a source of income.
- Preventing economic losses caused by landslides and improving the water flow for agriculture.
- Offering a unique selling point to corporate clients offsetting their carbon emissions.

Our company opens new and important possibilities by developing projects that are environmentally sustainable, and that support communities.

## Scaling up activities:

- Raise the national and international visibility of the work of Fundación Huellas Verdes on environmental challenges and of its social commitment.
- Acquire new customers, including companies known worldwide, to increase the number of hectares planted with vetiver and the number of communities benefitting from revegetation projects.
- Extend the activities of Fundación Huellas Verdes to other countries with communities facing similar risks.
- Obtain approval for the foundation's carbon offset stamp from the relevant supervisory authority in Colombia.

With the aim of working with communities whose living conditions are at risk from landslides, we developed the technology of revegetating slopes with vetiver.
