#### **Business model**

Amazóniko uses innovative technology to educate and ease the recycling process in Bogotá. Through its digital platform, the enterprise educates app users with a comprehensive recycling toolkit and organises easy waste collection. Amazóniko's points-based scheme rewards recycling by offering a growing catalogue of environmentally friendly products produced from the collected materials and discounts in associated brands.

The enterprise primarily targets increasingly environmentally aware citizens in Bogotá as app users, and actively works with associations of waste workers to extend formal employment opportunities and improve working conditions.

#### Social impacts:

- Providing formal employment opportunities for 200 waste workers in conjunction with a workers association;
- Improving health and safety conditions for formalised waste workers through the app's streamlined, door-todoor collection service.

#### **Environmental impacts:**

- Reducing the amount of recyclable materials that end up in landfills and waterways by collecting 900 kg of plastic, 600 kg of metals, and 550 kg of paper products during the pilot programme alone;
- Minimising the amount of ethylene, water, and energy inputs as well as CO<sub>2</sub> emissions production processes;
- Breaking the dependency on raw materials in production processes through promoting closed-loop production of sustainable products.

## Economic impacts:

- Offering sustainable brands and app partners the opportunity to access resource inputs in the form of recycled materials;
- Marketing green products through a rewards scheme;
- Providing formal & reliable incomes to waste management sector workers.

Amazóniko aims to raise ecological awareness, not only to show to app users the significant problem of waste in our rivers, seas and landfills, but also to demonstrate how small actions can result in great changes."

## Scaling up activities:

- Offer more sustainable products in the rewards scheme;
- Expand collection activities of recyclables to other major and mid-sized Colombian cities and increasing their recylcling rates;
- Market the app to a wider pool of potential users using digital platforms;
- Raise awareness about responsible consumption, correct separation of waste, and the importance of waste management; and
- Formalise the work of waste pickers or recyclers and improve their health and safety conditions.
