Daily Dump works to redefine people's perception of and relationship with the earth, each other and our urban spaces. It is the first company in India to design a home composter, adapted for tight urban spaces and with a unique terracotta design.

In addition to designing and selling home and community composters and related products & services, Daily Dump also raises awareness about composting and reducing waste and spreads the joy of composting through workshops and sessions in schools & communities.

Contribution to the SDGs:









Social impacts:

- Enabling more than 46 thousand families to compost at home using their products;
- Raising awareness for over 500,000 people about composting and a zero-waste lifestyle through workshops, videos, demos and partnerships; and
- Providing farmers with mineral-rich compost.

Environmental impacts:

- Keeping more than 40 tonnes of wet waste out of landfills every day;
- Preventing 4.34 tonnes of CO₂ emissions every day; and
- Returning carbon and nutrients to the soil by composting.

Economic impacts:

- Generating revenues and a stable market for Daily Dump and its partner co-operatives;
- Working with 18 potter communities, enabling them to earn 40% more and preserve their artisinal practices; and
- Largely employing women in a flexible, family-friendly work environment.

To achieve sustainability, we need to go beyond preaching or mere selling. We have to engage and empower the user."

Scaling up activities:

- Grow the number of families composting waste in the coming fiscal year by 15%;
- Reduce the amount of waste ending up in landfills by
- Develop a sensor-based app to measure the amount of organic waste composted with Daily Dump composters instead of ending up in landfills enable reward-based monitoring of savings;
- Build a robust supply chain from urban composters to peri-urban farmers to help regenerate the soil around Bangalore; and
- Expand the network of potters making composters across the country by 10%.







Partnerships

- O Go Get Garbage is an NGO that is helping Daily Dump expand their potter networks in the Northern part of India to regionally expand their outreach.
- Jaaga is an NGO partnering with Daily Dump to develop an app that collects data from the Daily Dump large-scale community composter.
